

Reverend Herbert Rochelle served as pastor during the 1980's. The front porch and bathroom was added during this time. In 1990, the concrete was poured for the fellowship hall. Union Grove was without a pastor during the time period of 1993 to 1995. Sunday school was held and guest preachers were invited to speak. Reverend J.O. Martin was one of the guest speakers.

Reverend Charles Bradley became the pastor in January 1996.

On October 28, 2000, the church received a bell for the bell tower. Donated by Stephen and Genie Harville, the bell was installed on Saturday and rang on Sunday morning the 29<sup>th</sup>. This completed a project began by the construction crew in 1922, but for reasons unknown, was never completed. Remodeling was also started on the bathroom.

#### Summary:

The Union Grove Cumberland Presbyterian Church will be 130 years old in 2001. On January 30<sup>th</sup>, the church property will be 117 years old and on May 30, 2001, the present church building will be 78 years old.
